



# Teacher Program Overview & Schedule

## Lights! Camera! Action! – Year 9 & 10

**Program Duration:** 45 Minutes

**Minimum Participants:** 20 Students

### Program Overview:

Lights! Camera! Action! is aligned with the Australian Curriculum Learning Area of Drama for Year 9 and 10 students. Throughout the program students gain the opportunity to explore aspects of characterisation and dramatic action with a focus on confidence and improvisation. Students will engage with the dark side of their favorite “heroes” to apply the elements of drama through the guidance of Warner Bro’s Movie World’s professional character performers. Students will build an understanding of the physical and psychological aspects of characterisation and how this influences intention and dramatic form. Students will leave this program with a greater knowledge and understanding of the elements of drama and dramatic form that can be applied to scripted and devised performance within the classroom.
